ORDINANCE NO. 17-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 6, STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING, SECTION 7-6-1, PARKING PROHIBITED, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF MANTENO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Manteno, as follows:

Section 1

That Title 7, Traffic Regulations, Chapter 6, Stopping, Standing, Parking, be amended by changing Section 7-6-1, Parking Prohibited, to provide as follows:

“7-6-1: PARKING PROHIBITED:

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with directions of a police officer or official sign or signal.

...

(L) Specific Streets:

...

Maple Street on the westerly side within two hundred feet (200') north of Maple Street's intersection with Third Street from the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. until four o'clock (4:00) P.M. only on school days when children are present.

Oak Street on the west side from Second Street to the southern limits, parking shall be limited to residential and parallel parking, provided no parallel parking shall be permitted between 1st Street and Division Street.

Raven Drive on the north side commencing one hundred sixty five feet (165') from its intersection with Cardinal Drive for distance of two hundred feet (200').

...”

Section 2

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 4

This ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after passage, approval and publication. This ordinance is authorized to be published in pamphlet form.
