ORDINANCE 17-24

FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES ON REAL PROPERTY FOR ALL PURPOSES OF DEFRAYING EXPENSES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR **THE VILLAGE OF MANTENO,** KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON MAY 1, 2017 AND ENDING ON APRIL 30, 2018.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Manteno, Kankakee County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes, legally made, to be collected from the real estate tax levy for the current fiscal year is hereby ascertained to be the sum of one million six hundred eighty thousand dollars, (\$1,680,000).

SECTION TWO: That the amounts hereinafter set forth or that amount as may be authorized by law be and the same levied for such corporate purposes as shown in Exhibit A, which is attached to and considered as part of this ordinance.

SECTION THREE: That the amounts levied for each object and purpose as set forth in Section Two of this ordinance, for which real estate taxes may be levied are as follows:

SECTION FOUR: That the total amount of one million six hundred eighty thousand dollars, (\$1,680,000) be and the same is hereby levied, assessed for all real property subject to taxation within the Village of Manteno according to the value of said property as assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the current year.

SECTION FIVE: That the Village Clerk shall certify to and file with the County Clerk of Kankakee County, Illinois the several sums above, constituting said total amount and the total amount one million six hundred eighty thousand dollars, (\$1,680,000) which total amount the Village of Manteno requires to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year for the Village, and the Village Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of Kankakee County on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION SIX: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Passed by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Manteno, Kankakee County, Illinois at a regular meeting thereof held on the 18th day of **December 2017**, and approved by me as President on the same day.

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the Village of Manteno, and as such presiding officer, I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provision Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

CHECK ONE OF THE CHOICES BELOW:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing, meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, notice and a hearing were not necessary.

- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Law.


CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
